Second Call for the M4HUMAN Programme


Dear Professor Osipov,

The Gerda Henkel Foundation and the European Commission launch the second round of their funding initiative M4HUMAN (Mobility for experienced researchers in historical humanities and Islamic studies). Following a successful start last year, when some 40 applicants from 17 countries were accepted into the programme, the sponsoring partners are now offering additional funding for up to 60 fellowships.


